Course Descriptions

Fun with Technology (K – 5th grade) Limited to 15 students

Come be a part of this technological kind of fun class. This class provides a fun filled way to cultivate technology. Students will be working with robots as well as many other things!

Just Dance or Just Play (K – 3rd grade) Limited to 15 students

If you like to bust your moves or break out a good sweat, choose Just Dance or if you would rather use your imagination, socialize and interact with others, choose Just Play. Which one will you choose?

Crafts (1st and 2nd grade) Limited to 10 students

Directed Drawing(2nd – 5th grades) Limited to 15 students
